Dear Parents,

First of all, on behalf of all of the faculty and staff, thank you all so much for the terrific Teacher Appreciation Week! We have had fabulous lunches and delicious morning and afternoon treats all week long and have been wonderfully spoiled. We do so appreciate everyone's kindness and generosity!

Many of you have inquired over the past year about St. Mark's plans with regard to the use of iPads or other mobile technology. At this point, we are not planning for St. Mark's to become a 1:1 school (one laptop/iPad, etc. per student), but we are considering carefully all of our options. I believe it is important to keep abreast of technological advances but not be consumed by them. While there is absolutely no doubt of the importance that technological competence will play in the lives of our children, I am also keenly aware that St. Mark's graduates are entering high school, not college or the work force. We need to insure that they have the knowledge base, study skills, and work ethic for high school as well as the moral and spiritual formation to cope with the complexities of life as a teenager. We are not convinced at this point that 1:1 programming would further those goals, although we certainly recognize our responsibility to provide technological instruction.

St. Mark's graduates should be equally comfortable on the Apple and PC platforms. We do allow use of laptops and iPads by those students who wish to bring them. Among the possibilities we are considering as we continue to use technology as a tool for teaching and learning are Smart Board-connected iPads for teachers, an iPad cart that could be used by a whole classroom of students, alterations to our servers and network to allow for a formal BYOD (bring your own device) program in Middle School, or simply adopting policies which allow for the limited use of smart phone apps in certain classroom situations. Our Technology Director, Mrs. Ray, is taking the lead in exploring all these possibilities and working with the faculty to determine what will work best for St. Mark's students in the coming years.

Many congratulations are in order to 5<sup>th</sup> grader Emme Cehajic, who has been selected to represent all the non-public schools of Northern Louisiana in the state Student of the Year Program! Emme will travel to Baton Rouge next month to present her portfolio and be interviewed by the regional selection committee. We are so proud of Emme for all her accomplishments and for representing St. Mark's so well!

Love is in the air as we prepare for Valentine's Day next Tuesday. Walls are covered with "heart art," and Student Council has been selling Luv Pops all week long for 1<sup>st</sup>-8<sup>th</sup> grade students. Cupid's big day is a jeans day, but students must wear a Valentine themed or red or pink shirt in order to wear jeans. Homeroom teachers and room mothers will make plans for their class's party, but a sweet time is sure to be had by all!
